On 29 August 2005 Hurricane Katrina, America's largest and third strongest hurricane, hit southeast America with a dramatic effect.

Ten years on the city has many achievements including visitor expenditure reaching the highest in the city's history in 2014 when the city welcomed 9.785 million visitors, who spent a record-breaking \$9.733 billion.

The Urbanna Oyster Festival, Virginia, USA

Virginia is known as the Oyster Capital of the East Coast and the state is now the largest producer of fresh, farm-raised oysters in America.

And 75,000 visitors are expected to go to the quiet tidewater town of Urbanna in Virginia, one of the oldest and smallest towns in America for its oyster festival.

The Urbanna Oyster Festival is Virginia's official oyster festival and one of the largest and oldest festivals of its kind in the USA.

Located along the Rappahannock River, Urbanna is a rural community with a land mass of less than half a square mile and a quiet way of life in a sheltered deep-water creek on a tributary of the Chesapeake Bay.

Acacia Africa

Acacia Africa has selected its top six pick of the best safari's with exceptional wildlife sightings.

Swaziland

The Mlilwane Wildlife Sanctuary offers 4,560 hectares of grassland plains and granite peaks. The safari is on foot or by mountain bike with an optional overnight hack on horseback and sleep in a cave complete with San Bushman paintings.

Expect to find some exotic species in this conservation hotspot, such as the honey badger, dwarf mongoose, aardwolf and striped polecat, along with the more common hippo, ostrich, kudu, zebra and baboon.

Zimbabwe

The Motobo Hills National Park has one of the highest concentrations of leopard (estimated at five for every 16 square kilometres) in the world and it's a location for white rhino.

There are roughly 200 breeding pairs of black eagles in the park, compared to only 23 breeding pairs in the whole of South Africa.

Botswana

The award winning Moremi Game Reserve is located on the eastern side of the Okavango Delta.

It offers lagoons, floodplains and islands and its 4,871 square kilometres is the last major stronghold for the endangered wild dog, with around 30% of Africa's population residing here.

South Africa

The Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park is located between Botswana and Namibia in South Africa's Northern Cape province. The park is relatively undiscovered and generally crowd free year round.

Cheetah and leopard thrive, hunting in the fossil river valleys and the surrounding Kalahari dunes.



Zambia

Zambia's South Luangwa National Park is one of the best places to go wildlife viewing on foot.

Those travelling by 4X4 can also stay out in the park for a couple of hours after sundown to spot bushbabies and porcupines.

Uganda

The Queen Elizabeth National offers chimpanzee trekking in the Kyambura Gorge, where vervet and black-and-white colobus monkeys are also easily spotted in the trees.

Black rhinos in Africa

Over the past 12 months, the partnership has managed to move 1% of the total global population of this highly threatened species into a safe haven in Botswana's Okavango Delta.

The last in a series eight international relocations took place during May and June this year, with rhino sourced from five locations in South Africa and Zimbabwe safely transported to Botswana in a Hercules C130 aircraft.
