

The Gudenaen, Denmark's longest river

At over 98 miles (158 km) long the Gudenaen, which is Denmark's longest river, has its source at Tinnet Krat northwest of Tørring, in east-central Jutland, and flows to the Randers Fjord (a long inlet of the Kattegat sea) on the east coast.

On its way, the rivthe crosses the relatively high lying region of Søhøjlandet; passes woodland and is fed by numerous streams and wetlands that spill over into crystal clear lakes before it empties in Randers Fjord.

Randers

At the mouth of the river stands the historic town of Randers, with its narrow medieval streets, picturesque squares and cosy half-timbered buildings.

'The Star Route' is a 2.5 kilometre self-guided tour that starts at the central town square Rådhustorvet .

Graceland Randers, a copy of Elvis Presley's home in Memphis, Tennessee, has one of the largest collections of Elvis memorabilia in the world, gathered mainly by one local Randers resident.

Randers Kunstmuseum (Randers Art Museum) houses an extensive collection of Danish and International art from the 1800s to the present day including works by Hammershøi, Andy Warhol and Yoko Ono.

On the outskirts of town there is a variety of activities from biking, hiking, canoeing to some of the best salmon fishing in Europe in the surrounding lakes and rivers.

Silkeborg

Silkeborg is known as home of the prehistoric Tolland Man – a perfectly preserved Iron age body that was found in a nearby bog. The mystery surrounding this 4,200 year old man's death can be explored at the Silkeborg Museum.

Ry has the ruins of the most thoroughly excavated monastery from the Middle Ages in Denmark at the Øm Kloster Museum.

Located between the lakes of Mossø and Gudensø, it also house Denmark's oldest monastic garden, which contains over 60 species of cultivated plants used during the Middle Ages as well as medicinal herbs.

Skanderborg

The Museum at Adelgade Skanderborg "Slotsbanken", was once part of the royal garden of Skanderborg Castle that stretched down to Lake Lillesø.

Here are the remains of the German air force headquarters from World War II, where two bunkers have been adapted into The Museum of Liberation.

Outlining the city's occupation, resistance, and the liberation, it also includes one of the few topsecret ENIGMA code machines used by the German military forces and cracked by the British.

Camel racing

Camel races are a traditional wintertime sport in Ras Al Khaimah. Races take place at weekends on the camel racetrack, surrounded by dunes and sheltered by the thickets of Ghaf trees in Digdaga and Hamraniya.

On weekdays the racetrack is usually busy with camel trainers and colorfully clad camels which trot up and down the track, building up their stamina for the weekend races.

The official camel races are held on Thursday afternoons and early on Friday morning from October throughout the winter season.

Iceland water park

The Iceland Water Park has a range of water slides and activities.

National Museum of Ras Al Khaimah

Built in middle of the 18th century during the emirate's invasion by Persians, the National Museum of Ras Al Khaimah was originally the house of the Royal Family. In 1987, the late Sheikh Saqr Bin Mohamed Al Qassim opened the museum, which includes a number of local ancient monuments and a collection of archaeological artifacts.

Khatt Springs

A naturally hot spring, Khatt Springs has waters, rich in mineral content reach a depth of 90 feetunderground and with temperatures approaching 40° degrees.

Dhayah Fort

Originally built as a strategic military castle in the 16th century, the now rebuilt Dayah Fort is located on a mountain overlooking the Gulf,

Horses are part of the Arabic heritage, and the long relationship between Arabs and there is a wide range of recreational riding facilities in Ras Al Khaimah.

Ras Al Khaimah Country Club

Discovering the desert on horseback is an exciting outdoor experience and this country club has a horse riding school where beginners can learn horse riding in only three days.

AI Jazirah Aviation Club

Visitors can take flights in a micro-light aircraft and powered parachutes.

Seawings

The Seawings Urban Experience flying boat takes off from the shores of Ras Al Khaimah on a 45 minute aerial tour of the emirate before flying to Dubai.

Prince of the Sea

Named after the first Arab Seaman Ahmad bin Majid, the "Prince of Sea", is a motorised yacht which offers visitors a variety of sailing trips around the coast.

Excursions include daytime, sunset and dinner cruises offering visitors various activities covering swimming, snorkelling and the opportunity of spotting one of the rare green turtles at Al Marjan Island.
