Croatia

Croatia offers 1,244 islands strung along its Adriatic coast, has 16 UNESCO Heritage Sites and eight national parks.

Croatian beaches are some of Europe's cleanest, according to the European Commission and the European Environmental Agency.

The country's coast is deem second only to Cyprus for the quality and cleanliness of its waters, with 90 per cent of Croatian beaches judged to be of excellent quality.
