The Northumberland Dark Skies Park, UK

The Northumberland Dark Skies Park is a project to create Europe's largest area of protected night sky.

Northumberland is the northernmost county England. Its North Sea coastline is a designated Area The county is noted for its undeveloped landscape of high moorland, a favourite with landscape painters, and now largely protected as a National Park.

Northumberland is the most sparsely populated county in England, with only 62 people per square kilometre.

The county's dark sky bid has been lodged with the International Dark Skies Association and, if successful, will offer protection to 1500sq kilometres of Northumberland's dark skies.

Key organisations involved include Kielder Water & Forest Park Development Trust, Northumberland National Park Authority and Kielder Observatory Astronomical Society who have been working on the plan for two years.

Scientific organisations supporting the bid include Jodrell Bank and the Royal Observatory at Greenwich.

The Dark Skies Park would stretch from Hadrian's Wall to Wooler, with Key sites including:

- Cawfields, near the south west of the County, and
- Kielder Observatory, situated just half a mile from the Scottish border on Black Fell near James Turrell's Kielder Skyspace.

Both areas have dark sky status individually with the IDA bid uniting both areas under one banner.

The Observatory host a number of different night watch events and star gazing camps and it is becoming a popular tourism attraction.

Care for the Wild International: No Photos, Please!

Care for the Wild International has launched a campaign to halt tourist photos with wild animals.

The wildlife charity believes having photos taken with a wild animal in a tourist resort rewards animal abuse and can cause the death of 50 animals for every one used in the picture.

It says animals used for these photos are generally likely to:

- have been taken from their family at a young age, and their mother inevitably killed
- be the one survivor out of up to 50 animals killed in the process
- have had their teeth and claws ripped out, painfully, to prevent them fighting back
- be kept in dreadful conditions they are working animals, not pets, and
- be dumped/killed when they are no longer cute enough for photos

The No Photos, Please! campaign features three hard-hitting posters which will be translated into different languages, with messages :

- Smile! You've just killed my mum
- Photo for Facebook? You've just 'liked' animal abuse
- Say 1-2-3 Ouch! Flash photography damages nocturnal animals' eyes

The first office tower has opened at New York City's Ground Zero since the September 11, 2001 attacks that destroyed the World Trade Center.

The 72-story building stands empty at the moment, although two government agencies have signed leases for half of the building's space. Both the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey, which owns the site, and the city of New York committed to the space years ago to help jump start rebuilding efforts.

Sheathed in glass, 4 World Trade Center is the smallest of the four main towers on the site where 2,700 people died when hijacked airplanes crashed into the towers.

It stands 977 feet (298 meters) tall, a shorter, simpler version of One World Trade Center, which will not be completed until early 2014.

The National Trust and the First World War commemoration

With 2014 the Centenary of the outbreak of the First World War, National Trust properties throughout the UK will be putting on special events and tours to mark the occasion.

Pemba Island, Tanzania

Pemba Island has been separated from the mainland of Tanzania and Zanzibar for decades, leaving an untouched and pristine island of great beauty and fertility.

The mosaic of forests, swamps, mangroves, hidden beaches and lagoons is scattered with the ruins of mosques and tombs mostly reclaimed by the forest – sites that date back to Arab domination when Pemba Island was seized by the Sultan of Muscat (Oman) in the 17th century.

Pemba is the predominant global producer of cloves yielding around 70% of the world's supply and is also a traveller destination.

The luxury Manta resorts underwater bedroom began as a work of installation art in a Swedish lake.
