The Pavezzo Country Retreat, the Greek island of Lefkada

The Greek island of Lefkada is located between Corfu and Cephalonia, and is known for it's beaches (Porto Katsiki, Mylos, Kathisma), Onasis's island of Scorpios and the art festivals, organised every year.

It is reached by a daily one hour flight from Athens to Aktion airport, which is 30min from the city of Lefkada and reached across a small bridge that connects Lefkada with mainland Greece.

On the east side of the island, up on a hill overlooking the sea, is the village of Katouna. During the 50's it was abandoned by its villagers because the distance from the beach- 3km- was a major obstacle for the fishing community.

During the last two decades, many of those houses, have been acquired by new owners, the village is being reborn and is starting to get lively once again.

The Pavezzo Country Retreat has been created from renovated 19th Century houses. It comprises nine properties ranging from maisonettes to villas with private pools, all individually furnished with local antiques and set in gardens.

Walking in the Algarve, Portugal

The Rota Vicentina

The Rota Vicentina is a walking trail that runs along the rugged western coast of the Algarve to Sagres, offering stunning coastal views.

The route runs from Santiago do Cacém in the Alentejo to Sagres in the Algarve and is integrated into the extensive European GR11 route, which connect Sagres to St. Petersburg.

Over 60% of the land in the Algarve is protected and the new route is part of a tourism initiative created to promote areas of the Algarve beyond its popular southern coast.

The Costa Vicentina is one of the best preserved coastal areas of southern Europe and the majority of the area sits within the Costa Vicentina Natural Park.

The Via Algarviana

Another walking route is the Via Algarviana, which is one of the best ways to see the region's hinterland.

Ospreys in mid-Wales

The protection team guarding the nest of a breeding pair of ospreys in Mid Wales is expecting the first of three eggs to hatch over the next week.

The ospreys, named Monty and Nora, returned to the Dyfi Osprey Project on Montgomeryshire Wildlife Trust's Cors Dyfi Reserve at Derwenlas near Machynlleth earlier this spring.

Last year, they hatched three eggs in the nest and the trio of young birds has been tracked to Africa. They were first ospreys to hatch alongside the River Dyfi since 1604.

Polperro, which is situated on the South East coast of Cornwall, is one of the most picturesque and charming villages with its own working harbour and narrow winding lanes crammed with white-washed fisherman's cottages, many only accessed by foot.

Outstanding natural beauty

Polperro is situated in an 'Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty', was one of the first Conservation Areas in S.E Cornwall, and also lies in an area of Heritage Coast.

The Polperro Arts Festival

The Polperro Arts Festival (16 to 24 June) is a week-long festival of music, arts, dance and comedy.

A fascinating past

The village dates back to the 13th century, with fishing the main occupation of its inhabitants for centuries. Pilchards were caught in abundance in the 19th century and processed and packed in three factories near the harbour.

Smuggling was commonplace when Britain was at war in the 18th century, with tea, gin, brandy and tobacco smuggled to Polperro from Guernsey.

The 'Heritage Museum of Smuggling and Fishing' houses a collection of early photographs, ship models and memorabilia dating back over 200 years.

Polperro is well situated to explore further into Cornwall and is in close proximity to key attractions such as the Eden Project, the Lost Gardens of Helligan, the towns of Fowey, St Austell and Charlestown plus the National Trust properties of Lanhydrock, Anthony House and Cotehele.

Italo trains, Italy

Rail travellers in Italy now have a choice of high speed services on routes between major Italian cities, since new Italo trains began running on April 28.

Italo services are operated by Italian company NTV, the first privately run high speed operator to launch since deregulation of the European rail network in 2010.

Initially, Italo services run between Milan and Naples, calling in Bologna, Florence and Rome en route.

Services will be extended to cover more high speed routes later in the year, with new destinations including Venice, Turin and Salerno, gateway to the Amalfi Coast to be introduced.

Italo services are also the first completely ticketless trains.

Customers will simply need to provide the train staff with a reference given to them at the time of booking and the staff will be able to retrieve all their details from a mobile PDA device.
