Coal Carrying , Ossett, West Yorkshire 9 April 2012

Held each year on Easter Monday, the World Coal Carrying Contest is a test of strength and stamina in which participants carry 50kg (men) or 20kg (women) of coal over a mile-long uphill course.

The Olimpicks, Dover's Hill, near Chipping Campden, Gloucestershire 1 June 2012

Started by local barrister Captain Robert Dover in 1612, the annual Cotswold Olimpicks attracts thousands of spectators and features some well-known countryside games such as tug-of-war, obstacle races and wrestling as well as a few stranger events - including shin-kicking.

The two contestants first fill their trouser legs with straw - to help reduce the pain – before holding one another's arms and kicking each other wearing steel toe-capped boots.

This year marks the Olimpicks' 400th anniversary.

Cheese Rolling, Brockworth, Gloucestershire

4 June 2012

This annual event involves daredevils hurling themselves down the steep, grassy slopes in pursuit of Double Gloucester cheeses.

The race starts with the master of ceremonies rolling a 4kg Double Gloucester cheese down the hill. On the whistle, competitors run, roll and somersault down the hill after it.

The event dates back to medieval times and is popular with international competitors.

Egg Throwing, Helpringham & Swaton, Lincolnshire 24 June 2012

In the annual World Egg Throwing Championships, contestants must construct a gravity-powered egghurling device to launch an egg to a waiting team member.

To achieve points, the team member must either catch the egg unbroken or get struck by the egg. As the egg can be traveling at speeds of up to 120 mph this is particularly tricky and can be painful. Distances to be achieved start at 30 meters but can be extended up to 150 in the knock out competition.

Each August the Bentley Brook Inn in Derbyshire hosts the Ben & Jerry's World Toe Wrestling Championship.

Competitors locked their big toes together, and attempted to force their opponent's foot to the ground. The organisers applied (unsuccessfully) in 1997 for its inclusion in the Olympic Games.

The World Gravy Wrestling Championships take place annually as part of the Pennine Lancashire Festival of Food & Culture.

Teams slide around in lukewarm gravy and attempt to wrestle on another to the ground. Team members win points for pinning the opposition down in the gravy.

Lancashire is known for the production of black pudding along with tripe (cow's stomach) and elder (steamed cows' udder).

The aim is to throw a black pudding that has been wrapped in a pair of ladies tights at a collection of Yorkshire puddings on a plinth 20 feet up a tower built in the middle of the main street in Ramsbottom.

Reasons to write about

South Dakota

South Dakota has five national parks, monuments and memorials as well as 54 state parks and recreation areas that allow visitors to experience the natural beauty of the state.

In the southeast, Lewis and Clark State Recreation Area features three campgrounds, biking trails, sandy beaches and the largest marina in South Dakota.

Palisades State Park features 50-foot cliffs composed of 1.2 billion-year-old Sioux quartzite, walking trails, campgrounds and historical sites.

Travellers to the northeast region of the state can visit Fort Sisseton Historical State Park, an area where history enthusiasts can take a guided tour and walk among 14 original buildings while adventurers explore the waters by canoe or kayak.

The state capitol of Pierre is located just below the Oahe Dam, Farm Island State Recreation Area and Oahe Downstream State Recreation Area allowing visitors to take in the Missouri River.

Nearby Lake Oahe offers world-class walleye fishing and outdoor recreation.

The western region of the state takes in the Badlands National Park, the Black Hills National Forest, Mount Rushmore National Memorial and the Custer State Park, Crazy Horse Memorial, Wind Cave National Park and Jewel Cave National Monument.

Canada and the Titanic

During 2012, the focus of commemorations for the 100th anniversary of the sinking of the Titanic will be on two Canadian provinces: Newfoundland & Labrador and Nova Scotia.

The RMS *Titanic* was on her maiden voyage from Southampton to New York when, just before midnight on 14 April 1912, she struck an iceberg 380 miles southeast of Newfoundland.

The White Star Liner, a celebrity among ships and dubbed the 'unsinkable' – sank. More than 1,500 of the 2,200 passengers and crew drowned.

The survivors went on to New York, but the victims were taken to Halifax, Nova Scotia.



Newfoundland and Labrador

The closest land-based wireless station to receive the *Titanic*'s distress signals was the Marconi Marine Radio Station at Cape Race.

Opening this spring is a re-construction of the station named for the Myrick family, generations of whom worked there from 1874 to 2007. Find out how they coordinated rescue efforts; watch giant icebergs drifting south along 'Iceberg Alley'.

In St. John's, the Centre for Marine Simulation has a huge virtual reality production that recreates Titanic's bridge, with actors, ocean and the menacing ice (April 15 through the summer).

Also in St. John's, the Johnson Geo Centre's *Titanic Story* permanent exhibit analyses why the tragedy occurred, while The Rooms Provincial Museum has a collection of Titanic artefacts, documents and images, and a 'virtual Titanic' resource guide.

The Ryan Hotel that was designed in the same style as the Grand Staircase on the *Titanic*, and fitted by the same craftsmen.
