# **Antigua and Barbuda**

The Caribbean islands of Antigua and Barbuda offers a range of natural activities including:

### **Turtle watching**

Turtle watching season in Antigua offers visitors a rare opportunity to experience one of nature's most beautiful sights.

Pasture Bay Beach at Jumby Bay is one of the world's primary nesting sites for the endangered Hawksbill Turtles. Watching them is carefully monitored via the local environment awareness group. Find out more.

### **Frigate Bird Sanctuary**

Antigua's sister island, Barbuda, is home to the largest Frigate Bird Sanctuary in the world with more than 5,000 Frigate birds.

### The Antigua and Barbuda Humane Society

One way to get a view of Antigua's rainforest is to go Zip lining. This activity has lines starting from 53 feet up to 328 feet offering views only available by whizzing from one platform to the next.

Indian Town Point, on the eastern extremity of the island, is thought to have been an Arawak campsite prior to the arrival of European colonists.

### The West Virginia State Park System

West Virginia is located in the Appalachian and South-eastern regions of the United States, east of the Mississippi River.

It is widely known for its outdoor recreational offerings, diverse topography, and its political history. West Virginia is home to 2,000 miles of rivers and streams. In addition, both the Appalachian Mountains and the Allegheny Mountains extend into West Virginia.

The West Virginia State Park System which comprises 36 state parks, seven state forests, five wildlife management areas, the Greenbrier River Trail in the east and the North Bend Rail Trail in the north-central and western regions.

The state is around 80% forested and has become well known for various outdoor recreational activities including hiking, fishing, mountain biking, boating and white water rafting.

Conservation efforts among animals have also become important in West Virginia.



The state animal, the American Black Bear has become a symbol for West Virginia, but is still a threatened species.
