Gujarat is a state in western India. It has a coastline of 1,600 km, most of which lies on the Kathiawar peninsula.

It is bordered by Rajasthan to the north, Maharashtra to the south, Madhya Pradesh to the east and the Arabian Sea as well as the Pakistani province of Sindh on the west. Its capital is Gandhinagar, while its largest city is Ahmedabad.

Gujarat has 831 wetlands areas with 438 coastal and 393 inland, including 231 reservoirs.

Apart from providing food and habitat to a variety of resident birds, the wetlands in the state provides the perfect habitat for migratory birds.

The important bird species in Gujarat are :

- the Great Indian Bustard
- Houbara Bustard
- Lesser Florican
- four species of harriers
- the Lesser Flamingo
- Sarus Crane

- Demoiselle Crane
- Common Crane
- three species of Pelicans
- six species of Strors, and
- four species of Bulbuls

The Flamingo City in Kachchh is the breeding ground for the Lesser Flamingoes that visit the area in millions for breeding and the Great Indian Bustards are found in the Kachchh Great Indian Bustard Sanctuary
