The National Restaurant Association has welcomed an appeals court's unanimous decision affirming a lower court's ruling striking down the New York City beverage ban.

The ban would have prohibited restaurants, delis, stadiums and arenas, concession stands and food carts from selling sugar-sweetened beverages in containers above 16 ounces.

Banned beverages would have included soda, sweetened iced tea, some smoothies, coffee drinks and lemonade.

The National Restaurant Association fought the ban along with the American Beverage Association.

The Festa Dei Ceri (Race of the candles) is one of the oldest oldest Italian folklore displays.

The festival began as a solemn act of devotion on the part of the Eugubini towards their Bishop Ubaldo Baldassini which started in 1160, the year of his death.

Today, the abandoned settlement is regarded as one of the largest and best preserved examples of an 18th to 19th century merchant town anywhere in the Gulf.

Covering an area of 60 hectares, the archaeological site showcases remains of palaces, mosques, streets, courtyard houses, fishermen's huts, harbour and cemeteries.

The Al Zubarah is the first Qatari site to be added to the World Heritage List, which includes more than 900 historical and cultural sites around the world including the Yellowstone Natural Park in the United States of America and the Pyramids of Giza in Egypt.
