On Foot Holidays in Central Europe

Istria

The self-guided Istria itinerary meanders through meadows, up mountains and via vineyards, stopping at tiny pensions in hilltop villages. It concludes with a descent to the Adriatic Sea for two nights in a harbour town.

Rhine Gorge

This is a self-guided walk along the 65km-long Rhine Gorge, focussing on the waterway's lesser-known west bank (the 'RheinBurgenWeg').

It is a chance to see the Gorge's 20 castles, watch barges negotiate the sharp bends, potter around fortified, UNESCO-sanctified villages and then head for the lively beer gardens and Riesling vineyards.

Slovenia

This trip has guests staying on working farms and eating unusual Slovenian delicacies while walking through the Karst, a much flatter and less touristy area of woods, caves, rivers, villages and vineyards.

The Czech Republic

The self-guided Czech Republic walking trip takes in the 'Bohemian Paradise': an area of castles, mysterious rock labyrinths, pine forests and a conical-roofed hunting lodge.

The accommodation includes a night in a Baroque château, while Moravian wines, local herbal liqueur and beer.

Turtles on Abu Dhabi's Saadiyat Island

The critically-endangered Hawksbill sea turtles continue to nest on the sweeping beachfront of Abu Dhabi's Saadiyat Island.

The first of the season's nests have been spotted in a conservation areas in front of the five-star The St. Regis Saadiyat Island Resort and Park Hyatt Abu Dhabi Hotel and Villas.

Each nest, which can contain between 90-100 eggs, have been clearly marked to ensure hotel guests and staff don't disturb them. Hatching is expected within 50-70 days.

The turtles' annual return is testament to the success of a conservation programme, which was designed to ensure that as hotels became operational on Saadiyat Beach, the turtles would continue to choose the island as their nesting ground.



The Hawksbill is listed as critically endangered on the International Union for Conservation of Nature's Red List, as its population has declined by more than 80 per cent worldwide over the last three generations due to habitat destruction and poaching.

Since the monitoring programme began in early 2010, some 650 eggs have hatched successfully on Saadiyat.
