# Richard III King of England 1483-1485, Longleat, Wiltshire UK

A book that was given to King Richard III as a teenager has gone on public display at Longleat House in Wiltshire, UK for the first time since it was written 550 years ago.

The book, which was written on vellum and features tales by Chaucer as well as other popular stories of the time, is part of 'The King's Body: Richard III King of England 1483-1485' a new exhibition on the Yorkist king, which has opened at Longleat House.

As well as the signed book, the new exhibition features portraits on panel of the King alongside his two predecessors on the throne his brother, Edward IV and his nephew, Edward V as well as his successor Henry VII.

There are also original documents relating to the elder of the 'Princes in the Tower' who Richard was rumoured to have had killed and the three course menu for the coronation feast of Richard III himself.

The exhibition concludes with a copy of the First Folio Shakespeare of 1623.

# The Master Draught in Rothenburg ob der Tauber, Germany 17 to 20 May 2013

In 1631 during the Thirty Years War, Rothenburg was taken by catholic General Tilly.

Somewhat amused after being handed the welcome drink - a tankard holding 3 ¼ litres of wine - the General promised mercy if one of the town citizens could drink the whole tankard in one draught. Former Mayor Nusch took up the challenge and saved his town.

This episode was first performed as a festival play in 1881. Today, this event is recreated every Whitsun, when hundreds of citizens dress up in costume and take part in the Festival Play "The Master Draught", an historical procession through the old town of Rothenburg.

# The Big Cypress Indian Reservation, Florida

#### The Second Seminole War

In the 1830's, the United States was attempting to enforce its policy of Indian removal, with the Seminoles facing the loss of their homeland and their freedom.

After broken treaties and failed peace parley's, the Seminoles took up arms against removal, The US Government thought they could quickly overpower the Seminoles and waged the fiercest of all wars ever waged between the US Government and Native Peoples.

They burned settlements and captured, killed and scattered many Seminole families.

This seven year war cost more than the American Revolution and involved 52,000 soldiers fighting against less than 2,000 warriors. The Seminoles fought with courage and determination and had a unique knowledge of the land.

Although many Seminoles were killed or removed to present-day Oklahoma, they were never defeated, and to this day their 3500 descendants are known as "The Unconquered" Seminole of Tribe of Florida.

#### The Big Cypress Indian Reservation and Billie Swamp Safari

The Big Cypress Indian Reservation is an Indian reservation of the Seminole Tribe of Florida.

Located in the Florida Everglades of southern Florida, it is the largest of the five Seminole reservations in the state. The tourist attractions within the reservation is the Billie Swamp Safari, include Swamp Buggy Eco-Tours & Airboat Rides through 2200 acres of Everglades with native and exotic wildlife.

There are also snake and alligator and swamp critter show and the chance to buy souvenirs and authentic Seminole arts and crafts. A rustic camping village includes native-style *chickees* for overnight stays.

# The Talyllyn Railway, Wales

Passengers who boarded two specially decorated trains on Talyllyn Railway in Mid Wales for the Coronation Day celebrations on June 2, 1953 are being sought for a re-enactment this summer, which will be filmed for a BBC documentary.

On Sunday 2 June, the railway will be re-enacting the events of 60 years ago with the original locomotive and rolling stock. The railway also also hopes to find some of those who rode the train on that occasion.

The Talyllyn Railway is a narrow gauge railway that opened for goods traffic in 1865, and has operated continuously since between Tywyn on the west coast of Wales and Nant Gwernol, just over seven miles inland.

In 1951 operation of the line was taken over by the Talyllyn Railway Preservation Society and became the world's first preserved railway.

Operation of the line is primarily by volunteers from all walks of life, with a small paid staff. It is now a major tourist attraction in the mid-Wales area, contributing significantly to the area's economy.
