Woburn Safari Park, Bedfordshire UK

Opened in 1970, Woburn Safari Park is one of the UK's oldest wild animal parks.

Its animals include white rhino, elephants, lions, tigers, black bears, wolves, bison, giraffes, lemurs, zebra, camels, wallabies, penguins, three kinds of monkey and a variety of antelope species.

Established by the 13th Duke of Bedford on the grounds of Woburn Abbey, the park has a long history of species conservation dating back more than 100 years.

Today, Woburn Safari Park is internationally recognised as a centre of excellence for the conservation of endangered wildlife and houses probably the biggest concentration of critically endangered African ungulates (hoofed mammals) on Earth.

Woburn Safari Park is a member of and contributor to the British and Irish Association of Zoos and Aquariums (BIAZA) and the European Association of Zoos and Aquaria (EAZA).

Orlando saw record breaking numbers in 2010

Orlando drew a record-breaking 51.455 million visitors in 2010, up 10.5% from 46.6 million in 2009.

Domestic visitation accounted for 47.78 million visitors, a 10.3% increase over 2009; and international travel totaled 3.675 million, an increase of 12.6% from 2009.

With this record, Orlando is the first destination in the country to welcome more than 50 million visitors and remains the most visited destination in the US.
